

COMING EVENTS:

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Every Friday, during Lent, after the 8:30 a.m. Mass in English and every Wednesday, after the 7:00 p.m. Mass in Spanish.

LENTEN STONES: As you enter church, you will notice a basket of stones: please take one as you leave. The stone represents the problems, sinfulness, and challenges that you may carry. During Lent, place them in the stone. Think of that stone as if it were a sponge soaking up all the things that worry you. Carry it with you during Lent. On Good Friday, when you come to venerate the Cross, bring the stone with you. Put it in the basket at the foot of the Cross of Christ, and leave it there, giving the stone and all it holds in the care of Jesus on the Cross. Know that with his suffering, Jesus has redeemed you and given you the love and strength you need to face each day.

LENTEN TREE OF PETITIONS: Cards 3:38 on which to write your petitions are on the table at the entrance of the church. You may hang your petitions on the tree where they will remain until Holy Saturday.
