# MEMO FROM THE BISHOP

### COVID update:

Sonoma County Tier expected to change soon. An announcement is expected to come on Tuesday so no changes this week.

Moving to Red Tier does not alter our procedures at all since 25% capacity must be followed even in the Red Tier.

## TIME FOR THE EASTER VIGIL:

No vigil may begin (whether indoors or outdoors) prior to sunset which is approximately at 7:30 p.m. So 7:30 p.m. is the absolute earliest time for the Easter Vigil Mass.

### YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH:

Beginning March 10<sup>th</sup>, posted on the Diocesan website will be a series of brief Novena Prayers begging for the intercession of Saint Joseph. The diocese website is: <u>srdiocese.org</u>.



In recognition of April's designation as Child Abuse Awareness Month, a novena will be prayed throughout the Diocese of Santa Rosa. The novena will begin on April 19th and continue for 9 consecutive nights. Each of the nine nights will be led by a different priest of the diocese. St. Leo's will not be participating in the novena. Fr. Jojo will acknowledge April as Child Abuse Awareness Month by celebrating Mass with the recommended intentions and prayers for victims of sexual abuse.
